Summary: Collection consists of memoranda, telegrams, reports, and correspondence regarding U.S. Middle East policy during the Nixon years. One series of documents covers the “Jarring talks.” These talks were held under UN auspices and led by Gunnar Jarring of Sweden. The talks went on for several years and ultimately broke down because of the October 1973 war. Another series of documents covers the U.S. response to the 1973 war including Henry Kissinger’s several trips to the Middle East between November 1973 and May 1974. Other series in the collection include CIA situation reports, meeting files of Vice President Spiro Agnew, and documents from U.S.-USSR talks on the Middle East.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Nixon administration's five years in office coincided with a turbulent period for Israel and the Middle East. In a June 1970 memorandum from then National Security Adviser Henry A. Kissinger to President Richard M. Nixon, Kissinger wrote that the Middle East was the most dangerous foreign policy issue facing the administration, more dangerous even than the war in Vietnam. When Nixon entered office in 1969, Israel, Egypt, and Syria were just eighteen months removed from the Six Day War of 1967, and they would fight another war in October 1973, the Yom Kippur War. In between these two wars, a series of diplomatic initiatives attempted to bring peace to the region. This collection of *The Richard M. Nixon National Security Files* details the twists and turns in the Arab-Israeli conflict between 1969 and 1974.

The collection is organized into three basic series. The first series traces the diplomatic efforts between January 1969 and the October 1973 war. The second series covers the October 1973 war. The third series centers on the peace negotiations that followed the war, including Secretary of State Henry Kissinger's "shuttle diplomacy" to the Middle East, a trip by President Nixon to the Middle East, and documents on the Syria-Israel disengagement agreement of May 1974.

The first series addresses four pre-October 1973 peace efforts: the Jarring talks led by UN representative Gunnar Jarring; the U.S. peace initiative of June 1970; U.S.-USSR talks; and the Four Power talks between the U.S., USSR, France, and Britain. Among the issues covered in these talks were Israeli withdrawal from the territories occupied in 1967; Israeli use of the Suez Canal; freedom of navigation for Egyptian vessels in the Strait of Tiran; and recognition by Egypt, Israel, and Syria of each other's sovereignty. Ultimately, despite meetings in New York, Washington, Tel Aviv, Moscow, and Cairo, none of these talks produced a settlement that was acceptable to Israel or Egypt. The historic problems of the Arab-Israeli conflict proved unsolvable at this time and cold war tensions further complicated the discussions, with the Soviets supporting Egypt and the Arabs while the U.S. supported Israel.

The files on the 1973 war consist of State Department situation reports from the Middle East Task Force that reported on the fighting, as well as National Security Council (NSC) memos and State Department telegrams outlining diplomatic initiatives pursued while the war was in progress.

The third series focuses on the peace initiatives that followed the 1973 war, the most spectacular being Henry Kissinger's several trips to the Middle East between November 1973 and May 1974. The files include planning for the meetings, travel plans, summaries of meetings, and talking points for press conferences. Other documents include statements by Kissinger before, during, and after meetings, as well as memos from other State Department officials regarding their meetings with foreign leaders. To give some understanding of the ground Kissinger covered, during his first trip in November 1973, he made stops in Islamabad, Rabat, Cairo, Amman, Riyadh, and Tehran.

This final series also includes material on President's Nixon trip to the Middle East in June 1974. Like the Kissinger trip files, the Nixon documents include memos from NSC officials regarding planning and talking points for the trip. Other materials on the postwar peace process include documents from the 1973 Geneva Conference that convened under the auspices of the United Nations (UN). Symptomatic of the entire collection is the inauspicious start to these negotiations. A December 21, 1973, telegram for the U.S. Mission in Geneva reports that the start of the conference was delayed because the original seating plan called for the Egyptian delegation to be seated next to the Israeli delegation.

The collection includes documentation on the key leaders from Egypt, Israel, the Soviet Union, and the United States. These include: Anwar Sadat, Gamal Abdel Nasser, Ismail Fahmi, and Mahmoud Riad from Egypt; Yitzhak Rabin, Moshe Dayan, Abba Eban, and Golda Meir from Israel; Anatoly Dobrynin and Andrei Gromyko from the Soviet Union; and Kissinger, Nixon, George H. W. Bush, Kenneth B. Keating, Joseph J. Sisco, and William P. Rogers from the United States.

With its detailed documentation on a crucial period in Arab-Israeli relations, students of the Arab-Israeli conflict, peace and conflict resolution, international relations, and the Nixon presidency will find that this collection offers many different research opportunities.

Dear Mr. President,

On this occasion, I wish to express my deep appreciation for the very warm and gracious reception which you and the members of your Government extended to the United States delegation attending the funeral of former President Gamal Abdel Nasser.

As a leader, President Nasser did much to shape the destiny of his nation and the history of his era. It is significant to us that in his final days, he looked toward the prospects for peace as offered in the United States proposal for a limited cease-fire and for talks between the parties to the Arab-Israeli conflict. We are encouraged by that constructive choice and by your assurances to Secretary Richardson that under your leadership, the United Arab Republic will continue to pursue these goals. The achievement of those goals is among the highest hopes of my country as well.

As you are assuming the heavy burdens of office, I extend to you, Mr. President, my sincere wishes for success in your efforts to bring the blessings of peace and well-being to your people.
